ORDINANCE NO. 1018

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER XV, SUBSECTION 428, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CHAPMAN REGARDING THE OPERATION OF MUNICIPAL SEWER UTILITIES BY AUTHORIZING THE COLLECTION OF A SEWER INFRASTRUCTURE SURCHARGE FOR THE FUNDING OF REPLACEMENT, REHABILITATION, AND IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL SEWER SYSTEM.

WHEREAS the governing body of the City of Chapman shall approve the necessary ordinances and approve rules and regulations pertaining to the effective management and operation of all city utilities.

WHEREAS it is the responsibility of the governing body to maintain a fee structure for the municipal sewer utility which generates sufficient funding for replacement, rehabilitation, and improvement projects which maintain the sewer system in a safe and lawful condition.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CHAPMAN, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the Code of the City of Chapman is hereby amended in Chapter 15, subsection 428, to read as follows:

15-428. Sewer service charge.

- 1. A monthly service charge for the use of services rendered by the sewage disposal system shall be paid to the city by all persons, firms, corporations, and any organization, within or without the city, having a sewer connection, directly or indirectly, with the city shall be as follows:
 - a) The minimum monthly bill shall be \$20.00
 - b) Every one thousand (1,000) gallons \$3.00
- 2. All users of the Chapman wastewater collection and treatment system are assessed a monthly user fee to be established annually by the governing body.
 - a) The minimum monthly charge is \$20.00.
 - b) A fee for each one thousand (1,000) gallons of metered water averaged for the months of January, February, and March shall be charged as set forth above.
 - c) The average shall be computed in April for each sewage utility customer to become effective with the May sewage billing.

- 3. A monthly Sewer Infrastructure Surcharge shall be charged on every sewer utility account, regardless of type, for funding of infrastructure rehabilitation and improvement projects within the municipal sewer system. This fee shall be \$5.00 per month.
- **SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall, after approval and publication as provided by law, take effect and be in force as of the 1st day of January, 2019.
- **SECTION 4.** All prior versions of Subsection 15-428 of the Code of the City of Chapman are hereby repealed in their entirety.
